

Expo Center Facts

HISTORY

Chelan County has 33 acres of land on Wescott and Kimber Drive in Cashmere that has been used for 55 years for the Chelan County Fair. In 2008 the name of the facility was changed from the Chelan County Fairgrounds to *The Chelan County Expo Center*. The Expo Center is now maintained by Chelan County through an outside fund which is self supporting. The facility is open year round for the enjoyment of both citizens and visitors as a multi-purpose facility with 150 full service RV sites, a full size arena with grandstands, loading shoots, horse pens, inside horse stalls, a 28,000 square foot Pavilion and 6,500 square foot Event Center both with kitchen facilities, a gazebo and four display buildings. They have hosted Conferences, Weddings, Church Camps, Quinceaniera's, Family Reunions, Auctions, Trade Show, Rodeos, Horse Camps, High School dances and Rallies. They are the "Home of the Wenatchee River Bluegrass Festival" and "Home of the Chelan County Fair". They accommodate boats, motorhomes, trailers and more for 5 months of winter storage.
