Road Sign Awareness

Chelan County Public Works would like to remind all growers within the county to be on the look out for signs that are obstructed from view. During your upcoming pruning please look for any trees that may obstruct road signs in the right-of-way and help us re-establish a clear view to the roadway. Please keep in mind the additional sight restriction of leaves during the summer when reviewing the signs around your property. As in the picture below, the stop sign can be seen through the trees now, but will be almost completely obstructed once the new growth occurs next spring.



Restricting the visibility of road signs can lead to accidents. This can greatly impact you and your neighbors due to injuries, deaths, or legal issues arising from those accidents.
