



Chelan County Solid Waste Prescription Disposal

This disposal service is an effort to prevent illegal use of prescription drugs by providing a monitored drop-off location. This program also seeks to prevent disposal by flushing, where prescriptions enter wastewater and septic systems as pollutants. FREE drop-off disposal is available for the following: prescribed narcotics, prescription medications, over-the-counter medications, medication samples, pet medications, medicated ointments & lotions, vitamins, inhalers & unopened EpiPens.

DROP-OFF LOCATIONS:

(during business hours only)

For Wenatchee Area: Chelan County Sheriff's Office, 401 Washington Street, Wenatchee WA 98801 *(in the basement of the Chelan County Regional Justice Center)*

or

For Chelan Area: Chelan County Sheriff's Office, 207 N. Emerson Street, Chelan WA 98816

If you are unable to use one of these locations, mix your medicines with an undesirable substance, such as cat litter or used coffee grounds. Put this into a container with a lid, conceal any personal information and place the sealed container in the trash. Make sure your trash cannot be accessed by children, pets, or others who might be looking in garbage for drugs.
