In 2008, the City of Wenatchee appealed several Comprehensive Plan Amendments to the Eastern Washington Growth Management Hearings Board. It was found there was a procedural error with proper noticing. The Board of Commissioners rescinded the affected resolutions. Noticing errors were remedied and the Board of Commissioners readopted the applications. The City again appealed the amendments. The EWGMHB remanded the applications back to the County. Chelan County will rescind affected resolutions and Hearing Examiner Decisions. A determination will be made as to which applicants want to continue the process and reprocess any applications using a more detailed analysis and Findings of Facts and Conclusions. The staff will present a resolution to rescind the affected resolutions on May 26. The applications by Mr. Nelson and Mr. Thomas will be re-heard with amended Findings of Fact and Conclusions in a closed record hearing. The Gates and Cochran applications will be heard with the 2009 cycle of CPA Hearings.
