

Proposition No. 1

Property Tax Levy for Fire Protection and Emergency Medical Services

The Board of Chelan County Fire Protection District No. 5 adopted Resolution No. 06 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

This proposition authorizes the District to restore its regular property tax levy to \$.75 per \$1,000 of assessed value to be assessed in 2024 and collected in 2025. The funds will maintain and improve fire protection and emergency medical services, replace apparatus, equipment and facilities and provide for firefighter safety. The maximum allowable levy in 2024 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.

Outdoor Pool Maintenance and Operations Levy

This proposition, enacted by Resolution No. 1-2024 of the Upper Valley Park and Recreation Service Area Board, would authorize imposition of regular property tax levies of \$0.15 or less per \$1,000.00 of assessed value for each of six consecutive years, collected in 2025, 2026, 2027, 2028, 2029, and 2030, for the maintenance and operation of the outdoor pool aquatic center in Leavenworth, Washington.
