Beginning February 4, voters registering or updating their existing registration in time for the February 11, 2025 Special Election will need to appear in-person at any election's office no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day, February 11. Chelan County Elections Office is located at 350 Orondo Ave., Level 3 Ste 306, Wenatchee.
