<i>What is the width of the two bridges coming in?</i>	Both are ~14' wide.	3/12/25
<i>What are the load ratings of the two bridges?</i>	The concrete decked bridge is WSDOT HL93. The prefab-steel bridge is HS25	3/12/25
<i>Will any improvements be made to the private road in/ access routes?</i>	There will likely be improvements made associated with the larger earthwork/ restoration contract. This could include brushing of the roads edge, minor resurfacing, minor widening etc. Any improvements to the private road in would remain for the planting contractor. The lower access route however are slated to be decommissioned. But, discussions could be had to sequence this decommissioning of specific access routes in a way that allowed the planting contractor access with equipment once both contractors are selected and if both agree.	3/12/25
<i>Are there warranties on plant survivability on this Contract?</i>	No. Assuming the Contractor installs the plants in the locations and to the depths required, and all plants provided meet the health and vigor standards outlined, all post installation survivability monitoring and maintenance will be handled by the Contracting Agency.	3/12/25

And for the price proposed within. The Contractor may propose any method for installation that meets the intent of the plans and specs and associated permits.</p>	<p>3/12/25</p>

<p><i>Do you anticipate the side channel to be dry? Can we track across to get to the planting areas on the other side?</i></p>	<p>We do anticipate the side channel to be dry. And the Contractor will be able to track across, with the expectation that the banks and channel bed are restored under the Temp Access and Staging if damage occurs.</p>	<p>3/12/25</p>
